- Low conductors
- All cables in correct position/height
- Fallen Trees and Branches resting on other branches or conductors
- Rising water levels
- Wet boggy conditions underfoot
- Mud and Slippery surfaces underfoot
- Isolated gusts of wind
- Loose tiles/slates on rooves



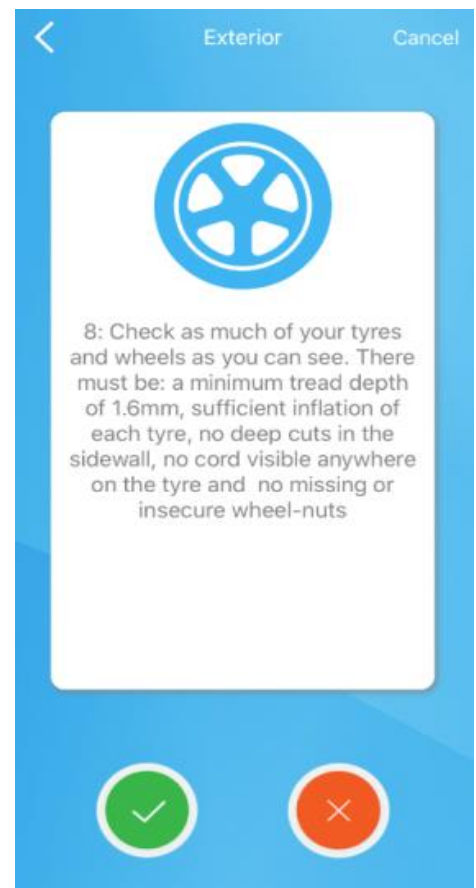
## Tyres

There have been a large number of issues recently with Tyres, we have suffered normal punctures, slow punctures, worn tyres and even a faulty tyre fitted by Kwik Fit! At all times please consider your parking location/position and the potential hazards to your tyres!

Before you tick the answer on your vehicle check app:


- ✓ Give them thorough look over for wear, nicks, cracks, cuts and bulges
- ✓ Check tyre depth using the gauges we provided you
- ✓ Check for suitable inflation
- ✓ Check all wheel nuts are in place and secure

It is important to plan your 'Non-urgent' tyre changes, vehicle faults etc to prevent downtime and potential bonus deductions. Please inform us of your plans prior to commencing with them. Thank you.
